

Rahul in; Shreyas, Chahal out of World Cup squad

Kandy, Sep 6: K.L. Rahul, whose fitness has been a concern for the past few months and is yet to play a match for India since his injury during 2023 IPL, has been named in the Indian 2023 ODI World Cup squad.

Whereas, Sanju Samson who has been travelling with the squad as backup for Rahul for Asia Cup, has been dropped, along with Prasad Krishna and Tilak Varma.

Rahul is expected to join Team India ahead of the Super 4 game against Pakistan in the ongoing Asia Cup.

Yuzvendra Chahal, who was dropped from Asia Cup, also did not find his name in the World Cup squad.

For those who have missed out on the World Cup squad, Captain Rohit Sharma had a piece of advice asking them to cheer up and be optimistic as he had gone through such feelings in the past.

"There will be players who have missed. But that happens every World Cup. There is going to be disappointment, but we can only get 15 in. The talent we have in India is hard ... I have gone through it, I know how it feels. You have to keep your chin up ... it

Proteas keeper to hang gloves

South Africa's ace batter and wicket-keeper Quinton de Kock will step away from ODI cricket at the conclusion of the ICC Men's ODI Cricket World Cup 2023.

De Kock has decided to retire from the 50-over format at the end of the World Cup, as confirmed by Cricket South Africa (CSA) in their squad announcement release.

Having made his ODI debut in 2013, De Kock has represented South Africa in 140 matches so far, aggregating 5966 runs at an average of 44.85 and a strike rate of 96.08. He has 17 hundreds and 29 fifties to his name with a high score of 178 that came against Australia at Centurion in 2016.

As a wicket-keeper, de Kock has affected 183 catches and 14 stumpings, an ICC report said. The 30-year-old was a part of the South Africa squad in the previous two editions of the Cricket World Cup where he has scored 450 runs in 17 matches at an average of 30.

Replying to a query on team balance, Rohit said, "We have three all-rounders, four seamers, seven batters. I don't think we could do more than that. Whatever we had available, we gave it a thought to come up with the squad, so that we get some batting depth, spinning options ... For us, this is the best combination."

Backing Rohit's comments, Agarkar said, "There are discussions, because you want the best balance. Kuldeep takes the ball away from left-handers ... if you

have quality bowlers, they will get to the opposition." In the batting department, Rohit will be leading the pack along with Shubman Gill, Virat Kohli, Shreyas Iyer, Rahul and Suryakumar, who are in Sri Lanka to play in the ongoing Asia Cup.

Rohit said India lacked batting depth as he hinted that No.8 and No.9 were not contributing with bat in crunch situations. "We need to create both bowling and batting depth... that is what was lacking in our team for a few years. When you talk about batting depth, the No. 8 and No. 9 positions become very crucial.

"We have spoken to the bowlers... how they need to put their hand up to do the job for the team with the bat as well...it's just that you have to be mindful of what you do...i will try to use my resources the best I can," he said.

Many, many decades ago, while riding my motorbike as a teenager, I crashed into a car and was badly injured. At least the blood all over made others feel I was terribly hurt and the ones in the car, who were actually mechanics and were testing the brakes of the car they had just repaired, took me to the nearest hospital.

The lady doctor took one look at me, and cried out, "We can't do anything!"

I remember looking at her through all the blood and asking, "Don't you have children?"

"Yes, I do!" she whispered.

"Then think of me as one of them and please stop the bleeding!"

Well, the good doctor, and the nurses did do that, and later I asked her why she had refused to do anything at first. I saw her looking at the rough mechanics and I understood what she was leaving unsaid, "I looked at the men who had brought you in,"

she said in silence, "and felt if I did not save you, they would thrash me!"

She obviously had heard about the beating up of doctors. But, in all probability, I could have lost a lot of blood and maybe my life, if treatment had not been given.

This morning as I read that the Manipal police had booked four journalists belonging to the Editors Guild, for going on a fact-finding mission to the riot prone area, and reporting what they saw, I thought of that accident and the silent response of that good lady doctor.

Do remember that she was a well-qualified doctor, was working in a fully equipped hospital, and yet when she had to save a life, was afraid to do her duty. And soon, journalists who have learnt to sniff out news, and search for the truth, whose job is to report to you and me, what really is happening all over the country, will stop doing so.

I remember a few years ago,

in my daily column for Dubai's Khaleej Times I had called Hezbollah, terrorists, and there was a hue and cry from readers and the editor even threatened to stop my column. I stopped delving into the truth for some time, and then one day realised that whether the paper stopped my column or not, my job was to tell the truth to my readers and I continued to do so.

But for a few weeks they did manage to silence me, and like the scared doctor, thousands of journalists all over the country will react the same way after this arrest.

As a people, we need to understand that the press needs bodyguards, not policemen or the secret service or black cats, but you the people.

That doctor finally saved my life, and journalists who are allowed their freedom to write, will most probably save both yours and the life of our country..!
